

## **Walnut Chamber of Commerce Meeting Minutes - Tuesday, June 14, 2022**

Brent called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Main Street Update:** Tracey presented options for Garbage Cans throughout town. The Chamber has agreed to use its Fall Fest earnings to purchase these with the goal to have them installed before Walnut Days weekend. Cost is approximately \$500 per can, with \$40 for a rain cover.

**Walnut Days:** The Chamber activities for Walnut Days were reviewed. Chicken/Fish Fry supplies have been ordered by Sandy. Cost has gone up so prices may need to be adjusted. Brent has 3-on-3 flyers out. Working on shirt design and ordering medals from Breedlove's.

**Fall Fest on Main:** Some ideas for new activities at Fall Fest were presented. A scavenger hunt tug of war, lumberjack show, and golf cart parade were among the ideas. Band ideas were also discussed. It was agreed to hire a face painter for the day.

**Circus:** Marketing will begin soon for the circus tickets. Locations to sell tickets was discussed.

Minutes from the May meeting were reviewed. Kirsten made a motion to approve. Tracey seconded.

Brent presented the May Treasurer's Report. Hannah made a motion to approve. Sandy seconded.

Tracey made a motion for the purchase of seven new garbage cans for Main Street. Kirsten seconded.

**Old Business:** Brent mentioned the current vacancies on the board. Names were discussed. Angie expressed her interest in joining the board.

**New Business:** Watering of the flowers and plants uptown will now be handled by community volunteers and not the Chamber Board. Thanks to Kirsten for organizing this.
